Sub:- Pensions – sanction and release of pension and pensionary benefits to the employees under 10<sup>th</sup> PRC – Regarding.

Ref:- Letter No. Nil dt. 15.07.2015 received from the Progressive Recognized Teachers Union TS. Hyderabad.

In the reference cited, the Progressive Recognized Teachers Union, TS. Hyderabad brought to the notice to the Government that the AG is rejecting the pension proposal of the employees who retired after February 2015, and requested to issue orders to release the pensionary benefits.

2. The Government have issued orders in G.O.Ms.No. 33, Finance (HRM.V) Department, dated. 07.04.2015 for consolidation of pension / Family pension. It is also to inform that for revision of pension, it is mentioned at para 11.1 in the said G.O. that : "The employees who retired between 01.07.2013 and 01.06.2014 are eligible for revision of their pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 2015 notionally as per the orders issued in the G.O. 25 Finance (HRM.IV) Department, dated. 18.03.2015. As such, the pensions of these employees have to be revised notionally based on the revised pay in Revised Pay Scales, 2015 and monetary benefit should be allowed from 02.06.2014 only. In para 10 of the said G.O., it was mentioned that ~~the~~ in the case of employees who retired on or after 02.06.2014 the pension shall be calculated on the pay in Revised Pay Scales, 2015 only. Regarding Commutation at para 12 of the

said G.O. it is clearly mentioned that the existing table of commutation value shall be continued and entitled to commute 40% of pension and at para 11.3 it is mentioned that the difference of commutation value shall be allowed on the pension notionally fixed.

3. It is also clarified with regard to gratuity, existing ceiling of Rs. 8 lakhs shall continue to be paid till the issue revision of gratuity order.

4. Therefore, without waiting for further orders with regard to sanction of other pensionary benefits, the AG, Telangana/ AP are requested to consider the pension proposals as per the orders of G.O.Ms.No. 33 Finance (HRM-V) Department dt. 7.04.2015.
